In 1995 graduated cum laude from the Moscow State Institute of International Relations (MGIMO).

Started his career in 1995 as Attache at the Department of North America of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia.

1996-2000 – served as Chief of Protocol and Vice Consul at the Consulate General of Russia in San Francisco (USA).

In 2000 returned to the MFA's Department of North America, where until 2003 held various positions including that of an Executive Assistant to the Director of the Department.

In 2003 participated in the opening of the Consulate General of Russia in Houston (USA), where subsequently served as Consul and then Deputy Consul General until 2009.

2009-2013 – Senior Counsel and then Head of the Section of Economic Cooperation with Canada and the United States at the MFA's Department of North America.

2013-2016 – Deputy Director of the Department of North America of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia.

On December 19, 2016 arrived in Canada to assume the post of Consul General of Russia in Toronto.

Holds the diplomatic rank of the Envoy Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary, Second Class.
